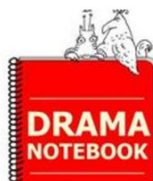

**Limited bus transportation for Stamford, Readsboro, Halifax, Wilmington & Whitingham residents is available on first come first serve basis.**

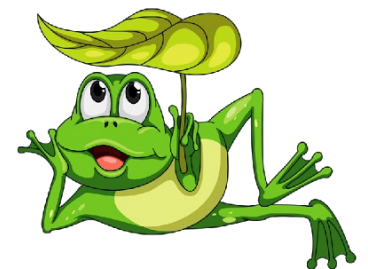

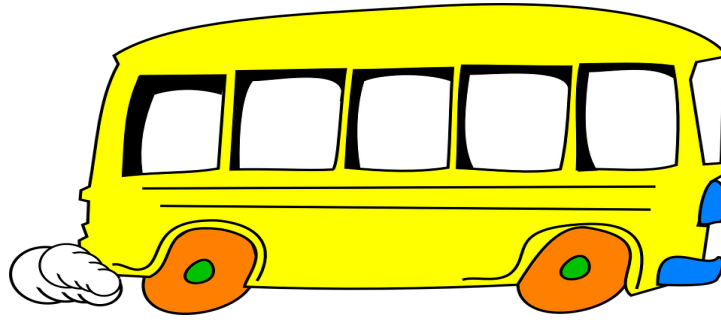

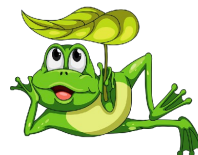

## Wings Summer Fun Registration
